

SELF CHECKING



Students will move the cards around to make a complete sentence. Next, students will type the sentence in Google Slides. In Seesaw, they can type or write the sentence, as well as read the sentence using the microphone.


Once students put the cards in order, the picture will show students that the sentence is in order.

The capital will be at the beginning, the period will be at the end, and word order will be correct.




Scrambled Sentences








- Print on card stock
